**NOTICE OF BAR DATE FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM  
AGAINST DEBTORS AND PROCEDURE THEREFOR**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on **October 14, 2003**, The Honorable Peter J. Walsh, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Delaware, entered an Order fixing **December 15, 2003, at 4:00 p.m.** (the "Bar Date") as the deadline for all persons and entities to file proofs of claim against **the individual Debtors in the LTWC Corporation, et al. bankruptcy**, Debtors and Debtors-in-Possession ("Debtors"), except for the claims described in paragraph 2 hereof. The Bar Date and the procedure set forth herein for filing proofs of claim apply to all claims against the Debtors arising prior to July 23, 2003 ("Pre-Petition Claims").

1. WHO MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM.

You must file a proof of claim if you have a Pre-Petition Claim not of a type described in paragraph 2 below. Acts or omissions of the individual Debtors that occurred prior to the Petition Date may give rise to claims against that Debtor, even though such claims may not have matured or become fixed or liquidated prior to the Petition Date. Any person or entity having a claim or potential Pre-Petition Claim against the individual Debtors must file a proof of claim on or before the Bar Date, no matter how remote or contingent such claim may be, in that specific Debtor's case.

2. WHO IS NOT REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM.

You are not required to file a proof of claim, if:

- (a) You have already properly filed a proof of claim with the Debtors' Claims Agent (as defined below); **OR**
- (b) Your Pre-Petition Claim is:
  - (i) Listed on the schedules of liabilities of any of the individual Debtors, which were filed with the Court on August 25, 2003 or any amendments thereto (the "Schedules"); **AND**
  - (ii) Not listed as "contingent," "unliquidated," or "disputed" on the Schedules; **AND**
  - (iii) You agree that your Pre-Petition Claim has been accurately set forth on the Schedules as to its amount and classification.

3. WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE. Delaware Claims Agency, LLC (the "Claims Agent") has been appointed by the Court as the Debtors' claims agent in the above captioned case. Proofs of claim must be filed so as to be received **ON OR BEFORE 4:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on the Bar Date** at either of the following addresses:

ANY CREDITOR WHO 1) HOLDS OR WISHES TO ASSERT A PRE-PETITION CLAIM AGAINST ANY INDIVIDUAL DEBTOR, 2) IS REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM IN THAT DEBTOR'S SPECIFIC BANKRUPTCY CASE ON OR BEFORE THE BAR DATE, AND 3) WHO FAILS TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM SO AS TO BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE 4:00 P.M. ON THE BAR DATE SHALL BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED AND ENJOINED FROM ASSERTING SUCH PRE-PETITION CLAIM AGAINST THE INDIVIDUAL DEBTOR OR FROM FILING A PROOF OF CLAIM WITH RESPECT TO SUCH PRE-PETITION CLAIM AGAINST THE DEBTORS, AND SUCH HOLDER SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOTE ON ANY CHAPTER 11 PLAN OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION IN THIS CHAPTER 11 CASE ON ACCOUNT OF SUCH PRE-PETITION CLAIM, NOR WILL SUCH CREDITOR RECEIVE FURTHER NOTICES REGARDING SUCH PRE-PETITION CLAIM OR THIS CASE.

4. WHAT TO FILE.

If you file a proof of claim, the proof of claim form must conform substantially to the official form number 10. You may use the enclosed form or obtain the appropriate form from the Clerk's Office of any United States Bankruptcy Court. Include all claims against the each individual Debtor on a single proof of claim form. Attach to your completed proof of claim form copies of any writings upon which a claim is based. If documents are voluminous, attach a summary.

**Do not file a proof of claim if you have no claim against the any of the Debtors.**

5. INDIVIDUAL DEBTOR CASE INFORMATION.

You must file a proof of claim in the case of each Debtor which you allege owes the debt. If you file a claim in the wrong case, that claim will be expunged by the Debtors in their objections to claims process. Below is a chart showing each individual Debtor's name, its doing business as names, EIN, and case number to assist you with determining in which case your proof of claim must be filed.

5. ACCESS TO SCHEDULES.

Copies of the schedules may also be purchased from the Court's copy service, Parcels (302)658-9971. Creditors wishing to rely on the Schedules shall be responsible to determine that their Pre-Petition Claims are accurately listed therein. Any other inquiries, such as whether you should file a proof of claim or take any other action respecting your claim, should be directed to your own attorney.
