**NOTICE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE
DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOR PLAN OF
REORGANIZATION OF HOLIDAY RV SUPERSTORES, INC.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY PROVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. On May 28, 2004, Holiday RV Superstores, Inc. (the "Debtor") filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Bankruptcy Court") its Plan of Reorganization dated May 28, 2004 (the "Plan") and Disclosure Statement for Plan of Reorganization of Holiday RV Superstores, Inc. dated May 28, 2004 (the "Disclosure Statement").

2. A hearing to consider approval of the Disclosure Statement, as it may be amended, is scheduled before the Honorable Mary F. Walrath on **July 7, 2004, at 3:00 p.m.** in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 Market Street, 6th Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard (the "Disclosure Statement Hearing"). The Disclosure Statement Hearing may be adjourned from time to time without further notice other than an announcement of the adjourned date at the Disclosure Statement Hearing or at an adjourned Disclosure Statement Hearing. Any party in interest requesting a copy of the proposed Disclosure Statement shall furnish its request in writing to counsel for the Debtor: Blank Rome LLP, 1201 Market Street, Suite 800, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, Fax 302-425-6464 (Attn: Elio Battista, Jr.). The Debtor will, at its own expense, provide a copy of the Disclosure Statement to the requesting party. In addition, copies of the Disclosure Statement and Plan may be found on the Bankruptcy Court's website, www.deb.uscourts.gov, and on file with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, 824 Market Street, 3rd Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.

3. Any objections to the Disclosure Statement shall be in writing, shall set forth the name of the objecting party and the nature and amount of any claims or interests held by the objecting party against the Debtor, shall state the basis for the objection and the specific grounds therefore, and shall be filed with the Bankruptcy Court together with proof of service **on or before June 30, 2004 at 4:00 p.m.** and copies shall be served so as to be received **on or before June 30, 2004, at 4:00 p.m.** by: (i) counsel to the Debtor, Blank Rome LLP, 1201 Market Street, Suite 800, Wilmington, DE 19801, Attn: Elio Battista, Jr.; (ii) counsel to the Debtor's Secured Lenders, Kaplan Strangis and Kaplan, P.A., 5500 Wells Fargo Center, 90 South Seventh Street, Minneapolis, MN 55402, Attn: Andris A.
